

How to reach Tomorrowland?

Train

Friday 27 July

On Friday you can take the train to Boom (L-train Antwerpen-Centraal – Puurs). A **free shuttle bus service** will bring you directly from the railway station in Boom to the festival area. A handy public transport planner can be found using this [link](#).

Saturday 28 and Sunday 29 July

On Saturdays and Sundays you can't reach Boom by train. Take the train to Mechelen or Antwerpen-Centraal (Antwerp) and take one of the following buses to Boom:

- **From Mechelen:**
 Bus 500 stops in front of the railway station (platform 10) and will bring you to Boom (see: "Bus").
- **From Antwerpen-Centraal:**
 Walk to the Rooseveltplaats (400m, see map) and take bus 500 to Boom (platform 40) (see: "Bus").

You can reach Tomorrowland from Antwerp or Mechelen with one of the following buses:

From Antwerp:

Bus	Itinerary	Closest stop in Boom
500	Antwerpen Rooseveltplaats – Wilrijk – Aartselaar – Schelle – Reet – Boom	De Schorre (main entrance)

From Mechelen:

Bus	Itinerary	Closest stop in Boom
500	Mechelen station – Walem – Rumst – Terhagen - Boom	De Schorre (main entrance)

Coaches

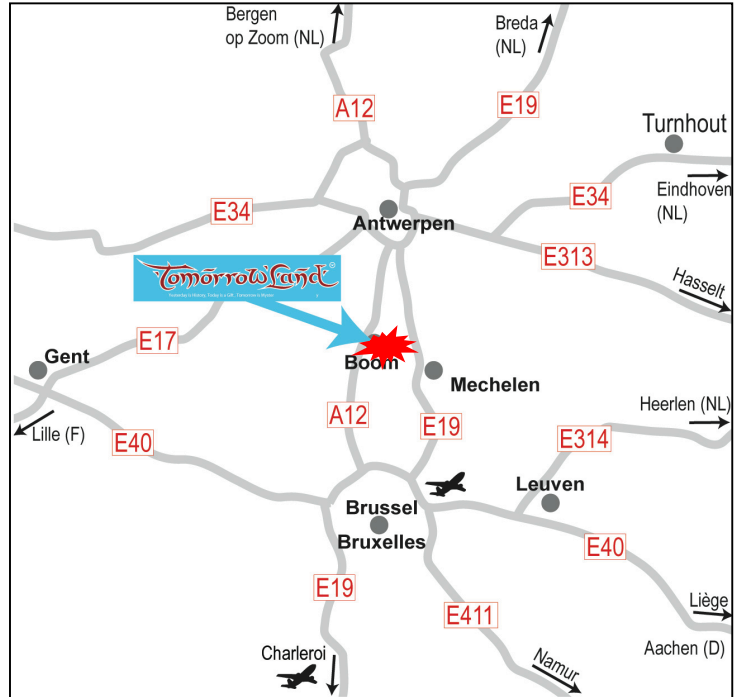
From several cities in Belgium and other European countries special coach services can bring you to Tomorrowland. Don't forget to book your ticket in advance!
 There is a **special parking area** for coaches on walking distance from the main entrance. Use this [link](#) for a detailed itinerary and information.

Car

Several streets will be closed for all traffic during the event. **We recommend following one of the itineraries listed below** to reach the festival site. All itineraries are signposted.

The festival area is situated in between the E19 and the A12 motorways and is easily accessible from both motorways.

- **Via the E19 motorway**
 - o **On the E19, take exit 8 Rumst** (GPS: Tiburstraat, Rumst), follow the signs “festival”.
- **Via the A12 motorway**
 - o **Coming from Brussels, take exit 8 Willebroek Noord** (GPS: Frans De Schutterlaan, Boom), follow the signs “festival”.
 - o **Coming from Antwerp, take exit 9 Boom** (GPS: Molenstraat, Boom), follow the signs “festival”.



In case of traffic jams, other itineraries will be signposted on the motorways. Follow the signs “De Schorre – Boom”.

Leave on time!

The parkings are on a distance from the festival area. A free shuttle bus service will bring you to the festival area and back to the parkings. Please take in account that the total travel time will be prolonged with approximately 1 hour due to dense traffic in and around Boom and the festival area.

Warning: Parking outside the parking areas will not be tolerated. Offenders risk a fine or their car may be towed away by the police.

Visitors with disabilities

Visitors with a physical disability can park their car at the main entrance of Tomorrowland. Take A12 exit 9 Boom and follow the signs “loge”. A European parking card for people with disabilities is required.
